2014 Pumpkin Run Show Chairman George Bryan's Blog

A few more show notes to keep everyone informed. Please keep up with our blogs, so by August when we start getting cranked up for the show, you will all know in advance most of the event plan and schedule. Awards will begin @1:45. Winners will be announced by class as a group. No 'special cars' parking. One space only per car. No multiple awards to any one car or owner. (Example - car can't be a class pick and also best of show.) More than one paid car registration by same owner OK, but only one Pick Award total for that owner if more than one car is registered. Multiple car registrations by one owner will count though for all cash drawings. Attendees including host car owners must park with their designated class in the assigned class area or they will not be eligible to be picked as a class winner; but will still, however, be eligible for all drawings.

Also, we're asking everyone to please not bring pets to the show.

Again, show day registration starts at 8AM and closes at 1130AM. No show day registrations are accepted after 1130. Plan your arrival to be here by 1130...we are serious this year about no exceptions for lateness and there will be no late entries. The committee unanimously agreed that people just have to plan to be at the show on time if they want to participate. We have set up a timeline and event flow to get this whole thing done, with an active moving show and a timely ending without a lot of geegawing around. Most of it depends on registration closing on time at 1130. Sorry in advance on behalf of the committee for being a little hard nosed about this, but the greater good of an active, moving, organized car show is the driving factor.

The committee also unanimously agreed there is no motorcycle/bike class for 2014. We are a car show and we have broken the classes out for a more fair representation of car demographics.
